

Chapter-2

The particulars of its organization, functions and duties.

Shri Harilal Bhagwati Municipal General Hospital, Borivli(West) is one of the Major Peripheral Hospital, Situated near the Northern end of the Western suburbs of greater Mumbai. It comes under the jurisdiction of the 'R' North ward office, Catering to the need of the patients hailing right from Film City Goregaon, to the interior of Thane District, Palghar, Dahanu Road and also from neighboring district of Gujrat. In view of the vicinity of Highway, Railways, Coastal line and slum areas and ever increasing population of suburbs, make this Hospital the Strategic Health Care Delivery Centre.

This hospital was inaugurated by then Dy. Prime Minister of India Shri Morarji Desai on 4.2.1968 with bed strength of 50 beds and over the period of time this hospital has developed into 373-bedded hospital. It is spread over an area of about 20,000 sq. meters.

Shri Harilal Bhagwati Municipal General Hospital is being headed by Dr. Krishkumar Pimpale, which is a Secondary care hospital and is affiliated to the B. Y. L. Nair Charitable Hospital for Tertiary care management.

Due to dilapidated structure of building, Shri Harilal Bhagwati Mun. Gen. Hospital, Borivali (W) shifted to Bharatratna Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Hospital, Kandivali (W) along with all departments and staffs on 04.10.2013.

In first Phase of redevelopment 110 bedded NTC Bhagwati Hospital started with OPD on 15.04.2016 and IPD (2 wards) started on 27.06.2016.

The following are the various services being rendered by the hospital.

1. 24 x 7 Medical Service
2. OPD and IPD wards
3. Laboratory and Pathology Dept.
4. X ray and Sonography dept.
5. Ambulance and Nurse Service
6. Nurses Training Centre and Hostel
