QUALIFICATIONS:

(1) Qualification and work experience:

Sr. Consultant: Should have a minimum of 8 years of experience after qualifying MD/MS/DNB or equivalent in the specialty concerned.

Jr. Consultant: Should have a minimum of 5 years of experience after qualifying MD/MS/DNB or equivalent in the specialty concerned.

The qualification in the specialty should be a recognized qualification as per the provisions of IMC Act.

(2) Teaching experience as post-graduate teacher (PG teacher) : A senior consultant can qualify as a PG teacher if he/she fulfils one of the following experience requirements :

- Criteria – 1: A teaching experience of 05 years in the specialty in a University setup as Assistant Professor / Associate Professor / Professor in the specialty in a recognized teaching institute / medical college OR
- Criteria – 2: A teaching experience of 05 years in the specialty in a NBE accredited department for DNB programme wherein the consultant has acted as a guide / co-guide for two DNB PG students and at least three thesis have been produced in the DNB programme under supervision of the consultants and accepted by NBE during association of the consultant with that department OR
- Criteria – 3: A clinical experience of at least 08 years in an organised clinical setup provided that he/she is willing to undertake the following in format prescribed.
- Intent to be a teacher for DNB Programme.
- Role proposed to play as a teacher for DNB Programme.

(3) Research publications & presentations:

The Senior Consultant should have a minimum of 3 research activities to his/her credit. The Junior Consultant should have a minimum of 2 research activities to his/her credit. These research activities includes publications such as research papers, review articles, case reports, abstracts etc. presentations such as papers/posters presented in conferences etc.

(4) Full time status of Faculty:

The applicant hospital shall be the principle place of practice of the consultants in the department and the consultants shall have no other academic institutional attachments/affiliation with other hospitals/other units of the applicant hospital, however, the consultants are allowed to have their own private practice in a non-academic independent setup.

GRADE:

Lumpsum total emolument will be -

Grade I - Sr. Consultant : Rs. 2,00,000/- per month

Grade II – Jr. Consultant : Rs. 1,50,000/- per month

AGE: On the last date (17/09/2021) of submission of the application by the candidate.

Age limit up to 60 years for application.

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

1. This appointment is purely on Contract basis and not regular basis.
2. The appointment will be discontinued at any time if not required.
3. Appointments will be made as per vacancies and requirements. However, Hon. Municipal Commissioner has right to cancel the selection list without giving any notice at any time.
4. Candidates who are in the Municipal Services must forward their application with the “No Objection Certificate” from his/her Head of the Department / Institution.
5. A recent passport size photo must affix in the application with his/her own signature on prescribed place.
6. Candidates must make sure that he/she has completed the qualifications and conditions. Candidature can be cancelled at any time and any stage, if candidate is not fulfilling the requisite qualifications and conditions, he/she will be dismissed from the services if appointed and no correspondence will be entertained.

7. Address of correspondence must be clear and complete with Pin Code Number, Telephone Number and Mobile Number with E-mail ID must be quoted in the application.
8. Candidate should have working knowledge of Marathi language.

A candidate must submit attested photo copies of school leaving Certificate, Birth Certificate, Domicile Certificate, Educational Qualification Certificates, Secondary & Higher Secondary School Examination Mark List, Employment Qualification Certificate. For married female candidate Marriage Certificate, Gazette Copy of Name Change. If it is not available, married female candidate can apply with their before marriage name. Candidate must furnish attested photo copies of Undergraduate and Post-graduate examination passing certificate if passed in more than 1st attempt.
10. Selected candidate will be appointed in any peripheral hospital where post-graduate D.N.B. programme has been proposed and may be transferred, if required to any other such institute under the jurisdiction of Greater Mumbai Municipal jurisdiction.
11. Candidature can be cancelled at any stage of selection process or after selection if it is found that candidate is not fulfilling the requisite qualification prescribed for the post or in case of false information / Certificates / papers or hiding of required information.
12. There will be a technical break and the contract will be renewed annually.
