HISTORY

K.B.Bhabha Mun.Gen.Hospital alongwith Sr. Cawasji Jahangir Ready money dispensary was originally established by the Ex. Bandra Municipality in the year 1914, with the generous contributions made by the Bhabha & other Parsee families from time to time. This hospital was gradually developed and when the Ex-local Body merged with Bombay Municipal Corporation in 1950, the hospital had bed strength of 44.

In the year 1957 a PNC ward with 21 beds was constructed between the labour ward and the dispensary raising the bed strength to 65.

In the year 1962, a Paediatric ward with 30 beds was started within the school premises at Petit School Compound opposite the hospital premises.

In the year 1967, a storey was raised over the hospital premises accommodating to more beds. Total bed strength 165.

In the year 1978 (DMC Zone III) was established who proposed expansion of the hospital envisaging a total bed strength of 500 had been piloted.

In the year 1987 April 30th a new building of 10th floor was started with bed strength of 436.

HEALTH CARE SERVICES

2. **SERVICES PROVIDED**

Responsibilities of K.B.Bhabha hospital, Bandra.

The hospital is responsible for primary as well as secondary health care services in following clinical branches of Medicines.

- 1) Medicine
- 2) Paediatric
- 3) Surgial
- 4) Gynac/Obst
- 5) Orthopaedics
- 6) Skin & V.D.
- 7) Psychiatry
- 8) ENT & Opthal.
- 9) Dentral

Hospital also provides

- A) Emergency medical Services round the clock medical care for critically ill/injured patient as well as other patients attending hospital beyond OPD hours. This department plays crucial role during disaster management in event of mass casualty of any type. Allied services like ambulance services for shifting the patients to central institute etc. are also provided round the clock.
- B) Diagnostic health care services : are provided through 1) Radiology dept. with imaging Ultrasonography 2) Pathology with blood Bank 3) ECG

- C) Supportive Services 1) OTPT dept. 2) Pharmacy department 3) Ambulance/Hearse services 4) Mortuary with 24 cabinets and cold storage facility.
- D) Immunization services provided as 1) Immunization for children as per WHO norms. 2) Immunization for pregnant women 2) Immunization for tetanus, rabies, hepatitis.
- E) MCH Programme 1) Antenatal services 2) natal services including assisted delivery in the form of instrumentation as well as surgical intervention 3) Postnatal services for mother & child 4) Family welfare services through health post and PPC.
- F) C.T. Scan, ICU, Paed IPCU, NICU, ECG, X-ray, USG, Patho.

The layout of K.B.Bhabha Hospital comprises of 4 premises.

- 1. Old OPD building that was started in the year 1978.
- 2. Main Hospital Building (10th floor) which was started in the year 1987 April 30th.
- 3. Psychiatry OPD premises which was started in the year 1997.
- 4. Semi Permanent ground floor structure was raised for Male & Female surgical ward with a separate operation theatre.
- 5. Refurbished OPD.
