- * There are 837 beds in Dharmashalas / Trust Lodges available elsewhere in the City of Mumbai in places which are not nearby the above mentioned hospitals.
- * Therefore, the total number of Dharmashala beds available in Mumbai are **1310 (473+837)** for outstation patients and their relatives.
- * Only 44% of the relatives requiring temporary shelter can avail the facilities of Dharmashalas.
- * 56% of the relatives are compelled to seek shelter in the open.
- * **Therefore, from the above data, it is clear that today approx. 2,500 beds are required for the outstation relatives accompanying the patients in the city of Mumbai.**
