The norms/standards set by the Department are as follows:

Surveillance Branch

1. Laboratory Technician: 70 slides of blood smear per day
2. Surveillance Inspector: To supervise the work of 4 Surv. Investigators
3. Surveillance Investigator: To visit 250 household per day and has to cover 15,000 population twice a month.

School Health Services

37 Medical Inspection Units is comprising of 1 Medical Officer, 1 Jr.Health Visitor, 1 Peon, visit the school everyday. There is a well planned programme for the academic year with set objectives.

The teams visits 1191 primary schools, 49 secondary schools & 18 schools for Mentally retarded children and carry out detailed medical inspection of children of Ist, IIIrd, VIIth & IXth standards.

Food Sanitation & Prevention of Adulteration of Food w.e.f. 5.8.2011 food safety and standard Act 2006 is implemented by Food & drugs administration (not MCGM)

Food Inspectors - 12 samples per month.

Municipal Analyst

The analysis of food articles is carried out as per the standards set out in Food Safety & Standard Act, 2006. The analysis of water samples is carried out as per the WHO and BIS Standards. The C.S. samples are analysed as per the Municipal Specification.
