The purpose of inviting this EOI is to shortlist suitable, technically and financially capable agencies possessing requisite land, infrastructure and operational experience for setting up and operating a 2000 TPD C&D Waste Processing Plant, in compliance with the Construction & Demolition Waste Management Rules, 2025 and the Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) of BMC.

3. Project Background

Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation (BMC), one of India's largest Urban Local Bodies, is responsible for managing construction and demolition (C&D) waste generated within its jurisdiction.

Due to rapid urban redevelopment, metro rail projects, infrastructure development, road concretization, utility works and building reconstruction activities, the city is presently generating significant quantities of C&D waste and excavated earth material. 1200 TPD (600 TPD at Dahisar & Diaghar each) existing recycling facilities are inadequate to handle future projected quantities, necessitating augmentation of scientific processing and resource recovery infrastructure. As a result, the generation of Construction & Demolition (C&D) waste and excavation material has increased significantly, with current generation estimated at approximately 8,000 metric tonnes per day, exceeding the city's overall municipal solid waste generation. BMC currently does not have suitable land available for establishment of a Construction & Demolition (C&D) Waste Processing Plant, as the available land parcels have already been earmarked/planned for other waste processing and waste management facilities.

BMC therefore invites Expressions of Interest (EOI) from experienced and financially capable agencies, consortiums, technology providers and infrastructure developers for establishment of a Integrated C&D Waste Resource Recovery Facility with capacity ranging from 600 TPD to 2000 TPD on a Design-Build-Finance-Operate-Transfer (DBFOT)/PPP basis or such other model as may be finalized during the subsequent RFP stage.

The objective is to identify technologically advanced and qualified participants for shortlisting and participation in a subsequent Request for Proposal (RFP) process.

In accordance with the Construction & Demolition Waste Management Rules, 2025 (effective 01.04.2026) and Standard Operating Procedure issued by BMC for C&D Waste Management within Mumbai city limits, and in furtherance of BMC's ongoing Integrated C&D Waste Management Portal initiative (digital registration, tracking and monitoring of waste generators and transporters), BMC now proposes to augment its physical processing infrastructure by setting up an additional Integrated C&D Waste Processing Plant of capacity ranging from 600 TPD to 2000 TPD capacity within BMC jurisdiction.

The proposed facility shall be developed as an integrated circular economy project focusing on:

- Scientific management of C&D waste.
- Resource recovery and recycling.
- Production of recycled construction materials.
- Reduction in illegal dumping.
- Maximum landfill diversion.
- Digital tracking and monitoring.
- Carbon footprint reduction.



- Promotion of sustainable construction practices.
- Compliance with C&D Waste Management Rules 2025 and applicable environmental regulations.

4. Project Objectives

The project aims to:

4.1 Capacity Augmentation

Establish integrated facility/Facilities capable of processing minimum 600 TPD of C&D waste (in City, Eastern Suburbs & Western Suburbs each, totaling 2000 TPD)

4.2 Resource Recovery

Maximize recovery of reusable materials and minimize disposal of residual rejects.

4.3 Circular Economy Promotion

Convert C&D waste into marketable products including:

- Recycled aggregates
- Manufactured sand (M-Sand)
- Road sub-base material
- Granular sub-base
- Paver blocks
- Kerb stones
- Concrete blocks
- Precast products
- Other BIS-compliant recycled construction materials

4.4 Digital Governance

Ensure complete integration with:

- BMC Integrated C&D Management Portal
- AutoDCR
- GPS-based Vehicle Tracking System
- RFID-enabled vehicle access
- Online MIS and Dashboards

4.5 Environmental Sustainability

Promote:

- Landfill diversion
- Carbon reduction
- Water conservation
- Renewable energy utilization



5. Project Capacity and Working Details

The proposed Integrated C&D Waste Processing Plant shall have processing capacity ranging from 600 TPD to 2000 TPD (in City, Eastern Suburbs & Western Suburbs each , totaling 2000 TPD):

- The plant shall be designed for scientific processing, segregation and recycling of mixed Construction & Demolition waste into usable outputs such as recycled aggregates, sand substitutes, and other construction-grade materials, in accordance with prevailing CPCB/MoEFCC and BIS norms.
- The plant shall be equipped with weighbridges, VTMS-linked vehicle entry/exit tracking, dust and pollution control systems, and shall integrate with BMC's Integrated C&D Waste Management Portal (MDCTS -model digital control & tracking system) for real-time reporting of waste inward quantity, processing status and output dispatch.
- The Participant shall be responsible for arranging land, required statutory clearances from MPCB/ CPCB, design, financing, construction, commissioning, operation and maintenance of the plant for the concession period to be specified in the RFP.

6. Eligibility Criteria

6.1 Land Availability

- The participant shall have a minimum of 5 (five) acres of contiguous land available for setting up facility from 600 TPD to 2000 TPD C&D Waste Processing Plant, either through ownership or a registered lease deed.
- In case of leased land, the lease shall be registered and valid for a minimum period of 10 (ten) years from the date of issuance of the Letter of Award (LOA).
- The land offered/proposed shall be located strictly within the jurisdictional limits of Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation (BMC). Land located outside BMC jurisdiction shall not be permitted / considered under this EOI, and applications proposing such land shall be summarily rejected.
- The land shall be free from all encumbrances, litigation and shall have clear and marketable title (in case of ownership) and shall be suitable (in terms of zoning / land use, access and other statutory requirements) for setting up a C&D waste processing facility.
- Documentary proof of land ownership (7/12 extract, Property Card, Index-II, etc.) or the registered lease deed, along with location details / survey number and a site layout plan, shall be submitted along with the EOI.

6.2 Technical / Operational Experience -- Existing Plant Capacity

- The participant must have successfully designed, developed, deployed and be currently operating at least one C&D Waste Processing Plant with minimum capacity of 200 TPD or one similar waste processing facility with minimum capacity of 500 TPD / similar project for



a Government / Semi-Government / Urban Local Body (ULB) / Public Sector Undertakings, during the last seven (7) year from the date of publishing of this EOI.

- **‘Similar Project’** shall mean any project involving design, engineering, development, financing, construction, commissioning or operation & maintenance of:
 - ✓ Municipal Solid Waste (MSW) Processing Facilities;
 - ✓ Waste Recycling Facilities;
 - ✓ Waste-to-Resource Facilities;
 - ✓ Integrated Solid Waste Management Facilities;
 - ✓ Infrastructure Facilities involving segregation, crushing, screening, sorting, recycling, material recovery or processing of waste/material streams.

6.3 Financial Qualification

The participant shall demonstrate:

- Positive Net Worth.
- Average annual turnover not less than Rs 50 Crore during last three financial years.
- Audited financial statements for last three financial years.

6.4 Other Eligibility Conditions

- The participant should not have been blacklisted or debarred from participating in tenders/EOIs by any Central Government / State Government / BMC / autonomous bodies / public sector undertakings during the last 5 financial years.
- The participant shall be a legally constituted entity (company / LLP / partnership / society, etc.) registered in India, and shall submit registration documents, PAN and GST registration certificates.

7. Consortium Requirements

Consortium participation shall be permitted.

Composition

- Consortium (Max. 2 members allowed) may include:
 - Infrastructure Developer
 - Waste Management Operator
 - Technology Provider
 - Financial Partner

Consortiums/Joint Ventures are permitted under this EOI. The Lead Member shall hold not less than 51% equity participation in the Consortium/Joint Venture and shall be responsible for coordinating all activities on behalf of the Consortium/Joint Venture. A duly executed Consortium Agreement/MoU shall be furnished along with the EOI submission. The detailed eligibility requirements, shareholding pattern, roles and responsibilities of members, change in consortium conditions, and other related provisions shall be stipulated in the RFP document. The



Consortium/Joint Venture conditions prescribed in the RFP shall have overriding effect and shall supersede any provisions contained in this EOI.

8. Scope of Work

8.1 General Scope

The selected participant shall be responsible for the design, financing, construction,, operation and maintenance of Integrated C&D Waste Processing Plant, ***with capacity ranging from 600 TPD to 2000 TPD*** located on land meeting the eligibility criteria specified in Section-5, within BMC jurisdiction (in City, Eastern Suburbs & Western Suburbs each , totaling 2000 TPD).

8.2 Land and Statutory Clearances

- Arrange a minimum of 5 acres of land (owned or registered leasehold for a minimum of 10 years from date of LOA) within BMC jurisdiction, suitable for the plant.
- Obtain all statutory approvals/clearances including Consent to Establish and Consent to Operate from MPCB, Environmental Clearance (if applicable), fire NOC and any other approvals required under applicable law.

8.3 Plant Design, Construction and Machinery

- The agency shall design and develop:
 - Waste receiving area
 - Segregation area
 - Primary crushing plant
 - Secondary crushing plant
 - Screening facility
 - Material recovery area
 - Product storage yard
 - Air pollution Mitigation Systems
 - Laboratory
 - Weighbridge facilities
 - Internal roads
 - Stormwater drainage
 - Fire-fighting systems
 - Administrative infrastructure
- The facility shall include following processing infrastructure:
 - Mechanical segregation systems
 - Crushers
 - Screens
 - Magnetic separators
 - Density separators
 - Washing systems (if required)



- Automated sorting systems
- Dust suppression systems
- Pollution control equipment
- The participants are encouraged to establish following product manufacturing facilities:
 - Recycled aggregate production units.
 - M-Sand units.
 - Paver block manufacturing.
 - Kerb stone manufacturing.
 - Precast concrete product units.
 - Non-structural building material production units.
- Provide dust suppression, noise control, and environmental management systems as per statutory norms.

8.4 Integration with BMC Digital Systems

- Integrate the plant's weighbridge and gate systems with BMC's Integrated C&D Waste Management Portal (MDCTS - on the Mumbai Debris Control & Tracking System Portal framework) for real-time capture of inward waste quantity, source/generator details, and processing/dispatch data.
- Ensure all incoming vehicles are tracked through VTMS (Vehicle Tracking and Monitoring System) integrated with BMC's portal, with geo-fencing and geo-alerts for unauthorized diversion.
- Provide API-based data exchange with the BMC Integrated C&D Waste Management Portal for dashboards, MIS reporting and compliance certification.

8.5 Operation and Maintenance (O&M)

- Operate and maintain the plant on a 24x7 basis (as required), ensuring continuous rated processing capacity is available
- Undertake preventive and breakdown maintenance, machinery upgrades and manpower deployment for smooth plant operations.
- Ensure scientific disposal/utilization of processed output (recycled aggregates etc.) and residual rejects as per applicable norms.

8.6 Reporting and Compliance

- Submit periodic (daily/weekly/monthly) reports on quantity received, processed and dispatched, through the BMC portal and in physical format as required.
- Maintain complete audit trail, digital records, and facilitate inspection/audit by BMC or its authorized representatives at any time.



9. Environmental & Sustainability Requirements

The facility shall incorporate:

a) Water Management

- Rainwater harvesting
- Water recycling systems
- Treated wastewater reuse

b) Air Pollution Control

- Mist cannons
- Dust suppression systems

Participants shall be encouraged to install:

Minimum 10% of total project area shall be developed as green belt.

10. Commercial / Financial Model

The commercial/financial model for the project (including capital cost arrangement, tipping fee/user charges, revenue-sharing, if any, and O&M cost recovery mechanism) shall be detailed in the subsequent Request for Proposal (RFP) to be issued to shortlisted/qualified participants. Participants may indicate, on an indicative basis, their proposed commercial approach along with this EOI, which shall not be binding at this stage including request of VGF, if required.

The project is envisaged under:

- Hybrid PPP Structure

The final commercial framework including:

- Tipping Fee
- Revenue Sharing
- User Charges
- Concession Period (15 years)
- Payment Mechanism

shall be specified in the RFP stage.

- Smart sorting technologies
- Digital twin platforms
- Carbon credit generation
- Smart logistics systems
- Mobile crushing units

Such proposals will be considered favorably during evaluation.

Applicants securing a minimum of **70 marks** out of 100 under the prescribed evaluation criteria shall be considered eligible for shortlisting for the subsequent stage. Notwithstanding anything contained herein, BMC reserves the right to modify, alter, revise, or waive any aspect of the evaluation methodology, qualifying criteria, scoring framework, or shortlisting process at any stage of the EOI, and its decision in this regard shall be final and binding on all Applicants.

13. Shortlisting

Based on evaluation of the submitted information, BMC may shortlist qualified participants as per evaluation criteria.

Shortlisted participants may be invited for:

- Technical Presentation.
- Site Verification.
- Demonstration of Existing Facilities.
- Participation in subsequent RFP Process.



14. Rights of BMC

BMC reserves the right to:
